Dr. Arun Kumar Chakraborty, Director General, National Library of India, Kolkatta visited Central library, PES university, Bangalore on 29th March 2019.

A part of the Ministry of Culture, Ministry of Tourism and Culture, Government of India, the National library is the largest (the only Category 6) library in India by volume, boasting a collection of more than 2.2 million books (which includes old, new, rare and digitized books) in different languages. National Library has a staggering collection of 24,65,342 books of which the number of books in the Indian languages is 6,43,255. Besides this, the library has an impressive collection of maps, manuscripts, current periodicals, newspapers including bound volumes of old newspa-

pers, Indian official documents and microfilms. The library also has an impressive collection of digitized images. Full text electronic journals are available for the readers along with high speed Internet connectivity to enable browsing of the contents of the library. The library catalogue is available on the Web to facilitate the readers. Besides functioning as a public library, the National Library has other important functions

Mr.Subhash Reddy, Librarian and staff members gave a warm welcome to the distinguished guest. At a special staff meeting, Mr.Subhash Reddy introduced Dr.Arun Kumar Chakraborty to the library team members and briefly highlighted the facilities, activities and service

of the PES university library. Dr. Arun Kumar Chakraborty, in an informal interactive discussion with the library staff spoke about the role of National Library and its objectives and services. Keeping in view of the growing application of technology in the library and information field and its emerging challenges, Dr. Arun Kumar Chakraborty stressed the need for developing professional competencies and network in the Digital Era. He emphasised on the continuous improvement in quality of collection, services and facilities to aim for achieving higher excellence and customer delight.

Collection Development





The library has print and online collections which includes books, e-books, electronic journals, newspapers, multimedia and a range of other e-resources. All online resources are available to you, 24/7 on and off campus.


During the financial year, Library received 807 purchase recommendations from all departments and received 421 books at total expenditure for ₹15,65,688.00. Regular updates about latest publications were sent to the Department/Chairpersons. Quarterly feedback on the purchase of books by department was sent to Department/ Chairpersons for information. Library received 619 donated books. As part of Library Spotlight 456 new books were displayed at the entrance of the library. The books on general interest, special topics in engineering disciplines and management were also included in the above display of books. Books are classified as per Dewey decimal classification and uploaded on OPAC. New arrivals of books are regularly uploaded on the library website.

Library subscribed 159 print journals at a cost of ₹5, 04,366.00. Latest journals received in the library are recorded and displayed. Regular monitoring of journals is being done and reminders of non-receipt of journals are sent to the vendors. Loose issues of journals are sent for binding when the volume is completed. Library subscribes to 14 national news papers.

Library subscribed 14 databases orders were placed with publishers for a value of ₹1738362.00. Access to over 6197 E-journals are provided to the users. E-Resources is provided in-campus and off-campus facility. Library users have accessed 60025 times of the e-resources across the campus.





most of the books are checked out at least once. Popular reading collections are heavily used and enjoyed by many faculty, students and staff.


Training and Development
